One of the things we completed at the Holiday Party in January was to survey the attendees to get your opinions and ideas on things you like and want to do more of. WESTGATE MARDI GRAS PARADE



This year marks the 33rd Annual Mardi Gras parade at Escambia Westgate School and the 2nd year of participation by our region. The members helped to bring joy, beads, and Porsche spirit to students on Friday the 20th of February, offering a celebration tailored for those with special needs who might not be able to participate in the traditional downtown festivities.

Designed with sensory accommodations in mind, the inclusive event gave students ages 3–22 the chance to experience the fun of Mardi Gras in a safe, welcoming environment. SONPCA were only one of about 30 entries who took part in the parade this year, including local krewes, first responders, and groups like the UWF cheerleaders and the Pensacola Blue Wahoos, who interacted closely with the students.

Teachers and volunteers emphasized the importance of bringing the Mardi Gras tradition to students who otherwise might be unable to attend large, crowded parades due to sensory challenges. The Porsche club is welcomed with open arms as frequent supporters for this program. For many participants and parade-goers, the Westgate celebration is one of the highlights of the carnival season — cherished for its inclusive spirit and the smiles it brings. ■■

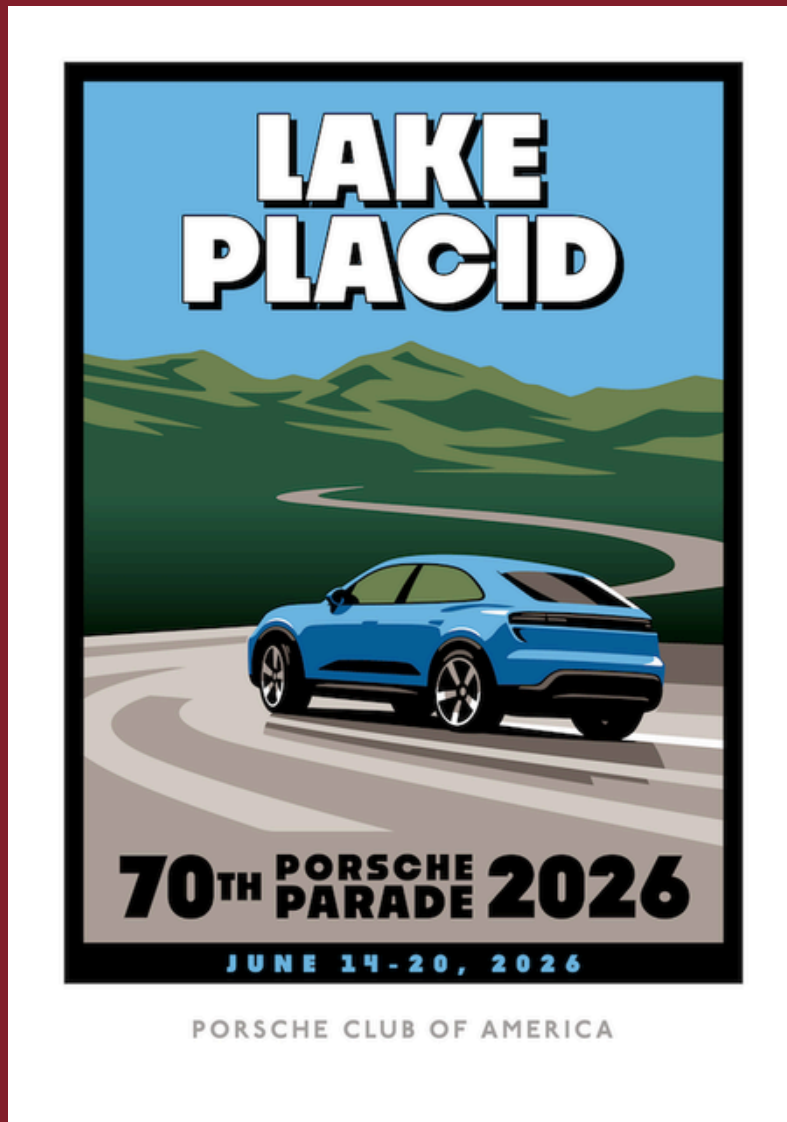

“BRUMOS COLLECTION TOUR

✂ On February 7, 11 PCA members from SONPCA — along with four members from two other PCA regions — gathered for a tour of the Brumos Collection in Jacksonville, FL. Friday evening, February 6, the group enjoyed an authentic Italian dinner at Poppy’s Italiano restaurant to get fueled up for our tour.

Saturday morning, February 7 allowed for an engaging blend of exploration, camaraderie, and shared appreciation for automotive heritage. Attendees had the chance to:

- Take a guided walk through both Forerunners and Frontrunners galleries.
- Discuss historical racing stories and Brumos achievements with fellow PCA members.
- Enjoy fellowship in a venue that celebrates both the engineering and cultural importance of the automobile.



What Is The Brumos Collection?

The Brumos Collection is a 35,000-square-foot automotive museum dedicated to preserving and presenting the history of automobile innovation and racing — particularly the heritage of the famed Brumos Racing team and its Porsche lineage. Located at 5159 San Pablo Rd S, Jacksonville, FL 32224, the museum celebrates both rare racing machines and the people who built, raced, and inspired them.

The collection isn’t just a display of cars — it’s a curated journey through automotive progress, told through immersive exhibits, interactive kiosks, and an extraordinary lineup of historic vehicles.

History & Significance

- **Origins:** Brumos began as an automotive dealership and racing enterprise — most famously fielding Porsche race cars that dominated American sports car racing for decades.
- **Public Opening:** Originally a private collection, the museum opened to the public in January 2020, offering rare access to cars once stored away from view.
- **Design:** The museum building itself is inspired by a 1920s Ford assembly plant in Jacksonville — a fitting homage to early automotive manufacturing.
- **Interactive Elements:** With digital kiosks and immersive exhibits, visitors can explore stories, specs, photos, and engineering details for nearly every car on display.

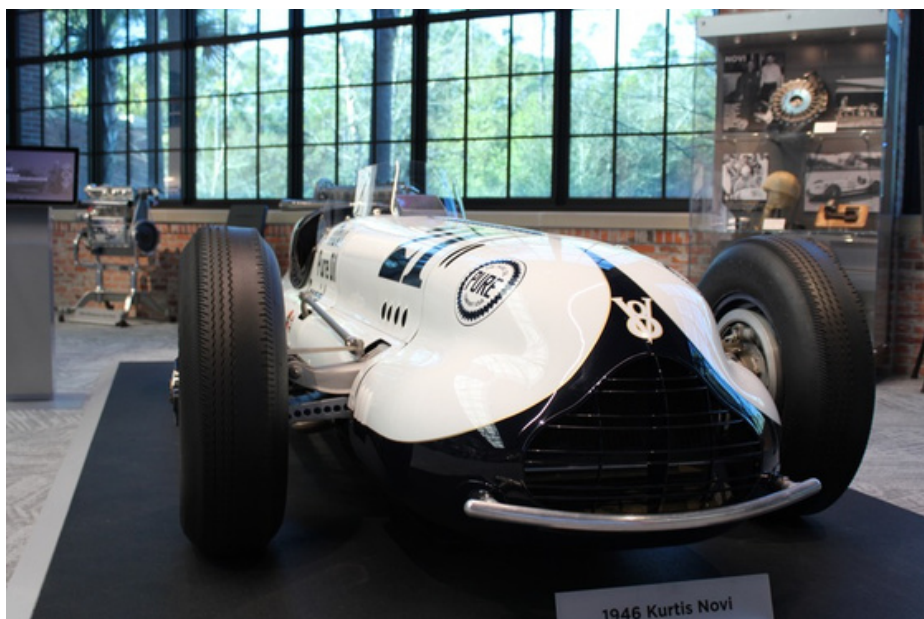

🏆 Frontrunners

Celebrating Porsche and Brumos Racing achievements, this gallery highlights performance cars that shaped motorsport history. Notable examples include:

- 1939 Alfa Romeo 8C 2900B — among the world’s most beautiful pre-war sports cars.
- 1967 Porsche 910, 1970 Porsche 908/3 Spyder, 1979 Porsche 935 — legendary racers tied to Brumos’ competitive legacy.
- Steve McQueen’s 1970 Porsche 917K — famously featured in the film *Le Mans* and a centerpiece of the collection.
- Rare vintage cars like the Miller Grand Prix racers, Peugeot racers, and more.



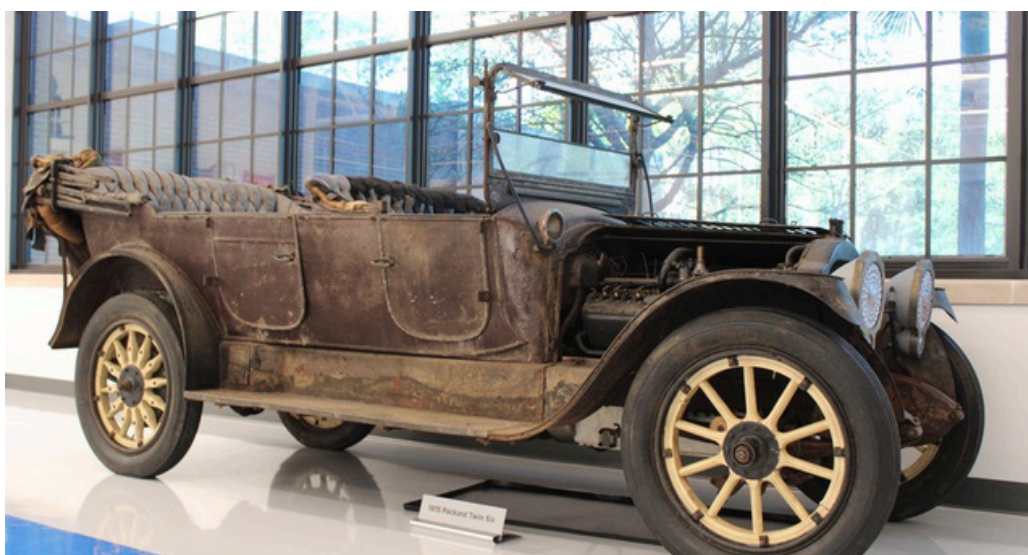
🧠 Why It Matters

Since joining the Porsche Club, we've really enjoyed connecting with fellow enthusiasts and look forward to participating in more rallies, drives, and showings in the future.

For our family, Porsche ownership isn't just about the car—it's about the experiences, the drives, and the memories created along the way. And judging by how much we enjoy those Saturday drives, the journey is just getting started.
