

## Meeting Minutes

April 20, 2017

PRESENT: Wally Lindenmuth, Bob Langham, Keith and Amy Boring, Pete Mellin, Stephen Pearce, Richard Birge, and Chris Sember.

TREASURER'S REPORT: \$6191.90 in account. PCA quarterly and annual rebates have practically paid for the Tallahassee autocross cones.

### OLD BUSINESS:

Autocrosses confirmed for May 20, September 16, and November 18, benefiting the Baldwin County Library. *May 20 is especially important to us, since it's the last chance for us to test our timing equipment before the Zonefest autocross.*

Ben (Alabama region) is planning events for June, July, and August. Insurance requirements were discussed.

MAY 26-28: Zonefest 2017, Memorial Day weekend, Tallahassee. *April 25 is the cutoff date for reservations at a discounted rate. May 15 is the cutoff for Zonefest registration.* Wally passed out pictures of the autocross area and asked members to submit ideas for the course design.

JUN 10: European Car Show at the Naval Museum. We're in charge. Museum officials want us on the most distant paved parking area from the museum. This area offers no shade, promises blistering heat, there's no way to plant the club flag, and it's a long walk to the museum's main entrance, the only way to get to the Cubi Bar. Board members voted to discuss these problems with the other car clubs, mentioning our desire to cancel this year's event and find a different venue for next year, which we'll offer to manage.

DEC 9: Christmas Luncheon. Stephen will check with the Gift Horse Restaurant in Foley, AL.
