1. 2021 Events Calendar. We worked on the Events Calendar, which is attached.

- Fairhope Arts and Crafts Festival. We have been invited by the British car club in Fairhope to join them. John Matus will be our POC.
- Children's Toy Parade. We will again support this annual PCA Zone 12 effort to provide toys for children at local medical facilities, scheduled for Saturday, December 4th. We are planning to do it at the Fairhope Rotary Youth Club. John Matus will plan this event.
- Porsche Mobile should be having an open house this year. Details TBA.
- Other possible events include:
 - An Atmore Rally (like Bill Mosely used to lead)
 - A tour of the Brumos Museum in Jacksonville
 - Attending a Space-X launch at Cape Canaveral (formerly Cape Kennedy) and visiting the Kennedy Space Center, both near Titusville.
 - An auto-cross in Tallahassee hosted by the North Florida Region. We have run this for them in the past, and it was very successful.
- Pete checked with the Naval Aviation Museum and learned they are not presently allowing car meet events, like we have done in the past.

2. Local Repair Shops. Wally mentioned that Autocheck has closed to new business, so most of us have started going to Palafox Imports, or the dealers in Mobile and Destin.

3. Auto-cross Location. We continue to look for a local suitable place. The Navy and nearby airports are not willing to let us use their airfields. Our rates are among the lowest in the area, as many hosting organizations have raised theirs.

4. Membership. Stephen reported we have 180 Primary members, 102 Affiliate members, 5 PCA Junior members, and 4 Test Drive members, for a total of 291. This is a significant increase.

5. Newsletter. Amy said she will start working on the next one. With so few activities going on, she doesn't get many articles.

6. Porsche Parade 2021. Wally mentioned it will return to French Lick, IN due to that location being so popular. There are three of us from Sonnenschein attending.

7. Treasurer Report.

- Pete reported that our balance is \$5430.
- In December we made four \$500 donations to four local charities.
- We made three \$150 donations to remember our three Sonnenschein members who recently passed away.
- Our holiday lunch at Jesse's cost the club about \$1200.

- Our 2020 tax forms, as a non-profit organization, were filed recently, ahead of the 15 May deadline.
- This week Pete will send in our incorporation papers with the state of Florida, as required by PCA.
- Audit. Wally asked if we are due for an annual financial audit. Pete explained he did one at the end of 2020 when he assumed the Treasurer position from Lindy, so we could wait until the end of 2021.
